COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A scenic, flat yet technical, 1.3-mile circuit in beautiful I'ON Village (located in Mt. Pleasant, just 4 miles from the heart of downtown Charleston). This is the same course as last year, suited for breakaway riders and sprinters alike. After the race, join the official after-race party at O'Brien's Irish Pub in I'On Village! COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is the same championship course that you loved last year! A perfectly flat, non-technical, safe, fast 1-mile loop with sweeping corners. Perfect for a beginner or a seasoned pro. The course encompasses beautiful Hampton Park, immediately in front of the Citadel (Just 2 miles from historic downtown). Have the kids play in the park while you enjoy some great racing. *Bring the camera, because award ceremonies will feature a podium awards ceremony!*

**** Field Limit of 50**

DIRECTIONS TO COURSE:

Take Hwy 17 North over the new Ravenel Bridge into Mount Pleasant. Continue straight through two (2) red lights. At the third (3rd) red light (South Shelmore Blvd – a CVS Store is on the corner), take a left and continue straight until you come to a round-about on Mathis Ferry Road. At the roundabout, go half-way around and continue straight into I'On Village. You will see signs to the race and parking.

Registration is at the Start/Finish.

DIRECTIONS TO COURSE:

From I-26 East, coming into Charleston:

Take the Rutledge Ave exit 219A to The Citadel - go 1.1 mile Turn right at Grove St go 0.3 mile Turn left at 10th Ave - go 0.1 mile

From Hwy 17 South (The Cross-town), take a right onto Ashley Avenue heading away from downtown and go all the way until it ends. You will see Hampton Park directly in front of you. Ample parking available all around the park.

Registration is at the Start/Finish.
